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## Healthy California for All Commission to Hold Inaugural Meeting January 27

**Sacramento, Calif.** — The Healthy California for All Commission will hold its first meeting January 27, beginning its work to develop a plan for advancing progress toward achieving a health care delivery system for California that provides coverage and access through a unified financing system, including, but not limited to a single payer financing system.

The Commission's 13 voting members include California Health and Human Services Secretary Mark Ghaly, eight gubernatorial appointees and four legislative appointees. There are also five ex-officio, non-voting members.
